**MARCEL DUPRÉ'S "LE CHEMIN DE LA CROIX"**

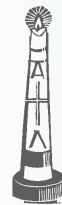
(WAY OF THE CROSS)

The cathedral choir sings from the triforium choir loft for this somber and reflective service of Holy Week. Traditional Latin motets of Palestrina, Victoria, and Ingegneri, psalmody and the Lamentations of Jeremiah are sung as the lights are gradually extinguished symbolizing the temporary triumph of the prince of darkness over the Light of the World.

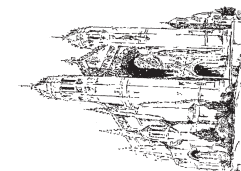

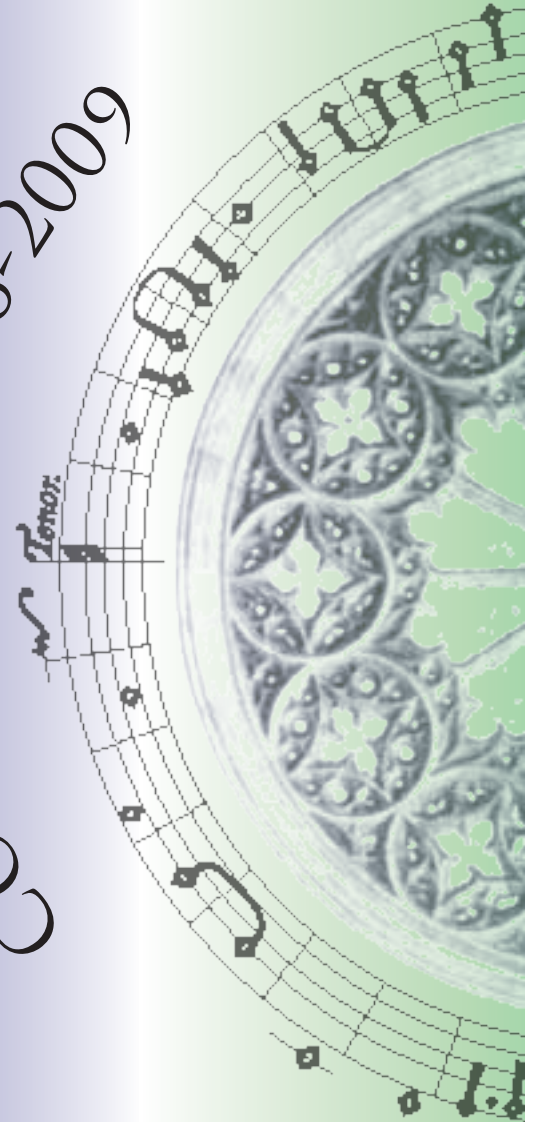
