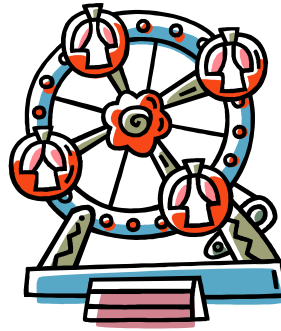

When you arrive at Cedar Point tell the parking attendants you are coming to **Equal Access Ministry Day with the Diocese of Toledo** and they will direct you to drive to the back of the park, past the marina to the **Hotel Breakers/Convention Center parking lot**. If you park in the main parking lot you will have a very long walk. **Parking at the Hotel Breakers is free.**

After you park your vehicle, look for the signs ("Equal Access Ministry") directing you to the **Coral Dining room**, where the tickets will be distributed from **10:00 to 11:00 a.m.**
