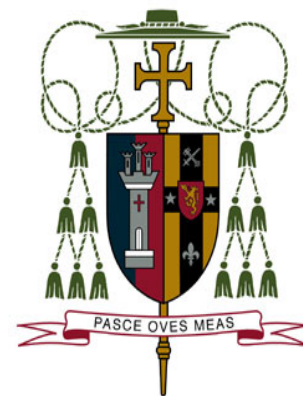

Advent

With Evening Prayer I of the First Sunday of Advent the New Liturgical Year of 2009 begins.



Pastoral Note:


(PN): The Lectionary Cycles are Year B for the Sunday Cycle and Year I for the Weekday Cycle (Vol. II of the four-volume Lectionary).

(PN): The official color for Advent is violet. In order to distinguish between Advent and the penitential season of Lent the bluer hues of violet may be used.

(PN): A penance service is best celebrated on a weekday during the latter part of the season.


(PN): Advent ends after Midafternoon Prayer (None) on Christmas Eve.

Easter

During the Octave of Easter (April 13 – 19):

- a Funeral Mass may be celebrated.
- a Marriage Ritual Mass may not be celebrated.
- a Rite of Marriage may be celebrated within a Mass of the Day. The orations, preface, blessing and readings are of the day. One reading may be from the Marriage Ritual Mass. A nuptial blessing may be given.
- A Rite of Marriage Outside of Mass may be celebrated.
- The double "Alleluia" is given at the dismissal during the Easter Octave and on the Solemnity of Pentecost and is NOT included during the Sundays of the Easter Season.





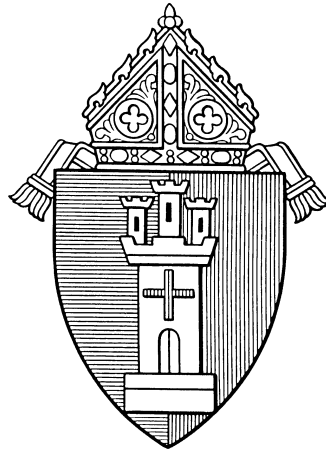
